CEF Language Levels

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEF) is a guideline used to describe achievements of learners of foreign languages across Europe and other countries. Its goal is to provide a method of learning, teaching and assessing which applies to all languages in Europe. The European Union Council Resolution recommended using the CEF to set up systems of validation of language ability. The six reference levels as described in the table are accepted as the European standard for grading an individual's language proficiency.
